



Cloverland Electric Cooperative's board of directors met on February 26, 2016 with all directors present.

- Approved a \$500 *Commitment to Community* request for the Walk for Warmth Schoolcraft County.
- Approved a motion to adjust the corporate matching donation to the United Way of the EUP and have the money available to sponsor other programs across the three districts.
- Passed a motion to accept the date of May 31 as the deadline to receive ballots for the 2016 director elections.
- Agreed to implement the Operation RoundUp program in the future and develop the program for member participation.
- Passed a motion to approve \$1,304.80 in estate retirements.
