CASE NO. U-15816 2014 RENEWABLE ENERGY PLAN ANNUAL REPORT SUMMARY

The Michigan Public Service Commission (MPSC) requires all Michigan electric utilities to get approximately 2 percent of their power supply from renewable sources by 2012 and increasing to 10 percent by 2015.

Under this requirement, Cloverland Electric Cooperative submits an annual report to the MPSC regarding its Renewable Energy Plan. Cloverland generated or acquired 396,056 megawatt hours (MWh) of electricity from their hydro facility, a hydro facility owned and operated by the United States Corps of Engineers, and from Wisconsin Electric. Of that 396,056 MWhs of renewable energy, 100,556 MWhs were sold or transferred, and 80,028 MWhs were used to comply with the Michigan Renewable Energy mandate.
