- Approved the purchase of 2.5 acres in Kincheloe to allow for the replacement and expansion of the existing substation in the future.
- Approved a donation to the War Memorial Hospital Foundation.
- Approved a request for assistance in upgrading the electrical system at the Chippewa County Fairgrounds in Kinross.
- Decided to postpone the leasing of the House of Bargains Building until after the canal wall restoration adjacent to the property is completed.
