



## 2018 Power of Excellence Scholarship Application

- Availability: Three scholarships (one scholarship per membership district)
- Award Amount: \$1,500 for use at any university, college, or vocational/technical school in the United States. The award will be mailed directly to the financial aid office on or before August 1 and applied to the student's account. The scholarship must be used for educational purposes.
- Frequency: One time, non-renewable
- Deadline: **Completed applications must be postmarked by April 11, 2018 to be considered.** All supporting documentation must be included with the application. Mail to: Cloverland Electric Cooperative, Scholarship Committee, 725 E. Portage Avenue, Sault Sainte Marie, MI 49783.
- Eligibility:
- Student/Applicant must be a graduating high school senior with a minimum 2.75 grade point average, based on a 4.0 scale.
  - Student/Applicant's parent or legal guardian must be a member of Cloverland Electric Cooperative and currently receiving electric service from the cooperative.
  - Student/Applicant must be enrolled or planning to enroll as a full-time student at an accredited university, college or vocational/technical school for the 2017 fall term.
- Evaluation: Applications will be evaluated on the following criteria: grade-point average (GPA), school involvement and achievements, community service and work experience, personal statement of educational and career goals, and letters of recommendation.
- Notification: Cloverland Electric Cooperative will only notify the award recipients. Winners will be announced by May 1, 2018.
